



# Winnipeg & District Table Tennis League



## GET OUT OF THE BASEMENT!

### What is it?

It's an individual table tennis league where players play for themselves and are ranked by percentage of their matches won and lost.

### Who is it for?

Everyone! All ages, M & F, from beginners to provincial team experts! Each night (based upon level of players in attendance) you are assigned to a division of play where you compete against players of approximately your own level.

### When & Where is it?

Every Wednesday night from Nov. 7 - May/June 2008 at Daniel McIntyre Collegiate, Lower Gymnasium, 720 Alverstone (Enter from stairs inside of front foyer). Doors open 6:30 pm, PLAY STARTS AT 7 PM SHARP and runs till 9-9:30 pm.

### How does it work?

Each night you arrive at 6:30 pm and register with the League Coordinator and warm up until 7:00 pm when the first round will begin. Inter-division play is first: AvsB, BvsC etc. The rest of the matches are against players in your own division. Players will get between 3-6 matches per night depending upon # of players in attendance. Stats are produced weekly and are posted on the MTTA WEBSITE at [www.mtta.ca](http://www.mtta.ca)

### The rules?

ITTF rules and regulations in effect. Matches are best 3 out of 5 games to 11 points changing serves every 2 points. Players must provide their own balls and paddles.

### How much does it cost?

Please see the bottom of this document for seasonal pricing. A \$5.00/ night drop in fee is also available for persons who cannot attend on a regular basis. Please note: If there are more than 20 players in attendance, persons who have paid for a full season will be given first matches.

### Signup Deadline

You can enroll any time throughout the season. However, it is best to be enrolled before the November 7th deadline to secure your spot. Please note: if you pay drop in fees and later decide to pay for the entire season, your drop-in fees will NOT be counted towards your season fee.
